# A wine region

## with rich diversity

### Chablis, Grand Auxerrois & Châtillonnais

The “Golden Gateway to Bourgogne” sits in the northwest of the Bourgogne winegrowing region and is home to **Chablis**, an internationally reputed dry white wine. A few hills away from Chablis, the **Grand Auxerrois** region offers a wide range of appellations. Further East, the vines of the **Châtillonnais** are almost exclusively dedicated to Crémant de Bourgogne.

### Côte de Nuits

The **Côte de Nuits** covers 20km north and south of Nuits-Saint-Georges. Known as the “*Champs-Élysées* of the Bourgogne region”, it is home to many *Grand Cru appellations*, thanks to its ideal conditions so loved by the *Pinot Noir* grape. Celebrated for its reds, the *Côte de Nuits* also produces some prime whites.

### Côte de Beaune

Then comes the **Côte de Beaune**, where the famous names of the wine-producing villages bring a sparkle to the eyes of connoisseurs. This exceptional winegrowing region produces some of the world’s greatest reds and whites. The charming city of Beaune, the capital of Bourgogne wine, is an essential port of call.

### Côte Chalonnaise & Couchois

Farther south, the landscape becomes more varied and contrasting. The vines of the **Côte Chalonnaise** and the **Couchois** cover the best hillsides, producing ruby reds and delicate whites.

### Mâconnais

At the very south of the region, the **Mâconnais** offers a touch of the Mediterranean. The sun is hotter here, producing rounded, crisp, aromatic whites, and also a few charming fruity reds.

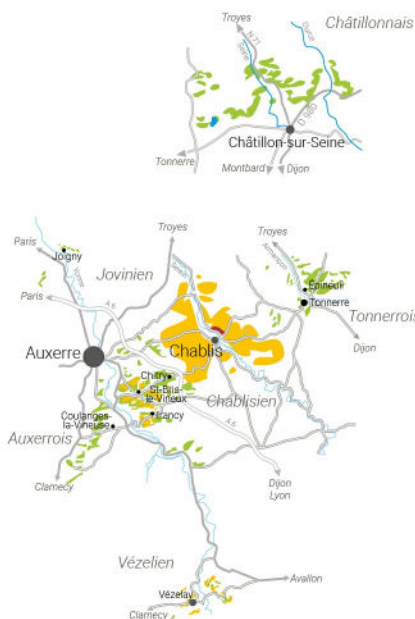

- Corporate Social Responsibility (Sustainable winegrowing).



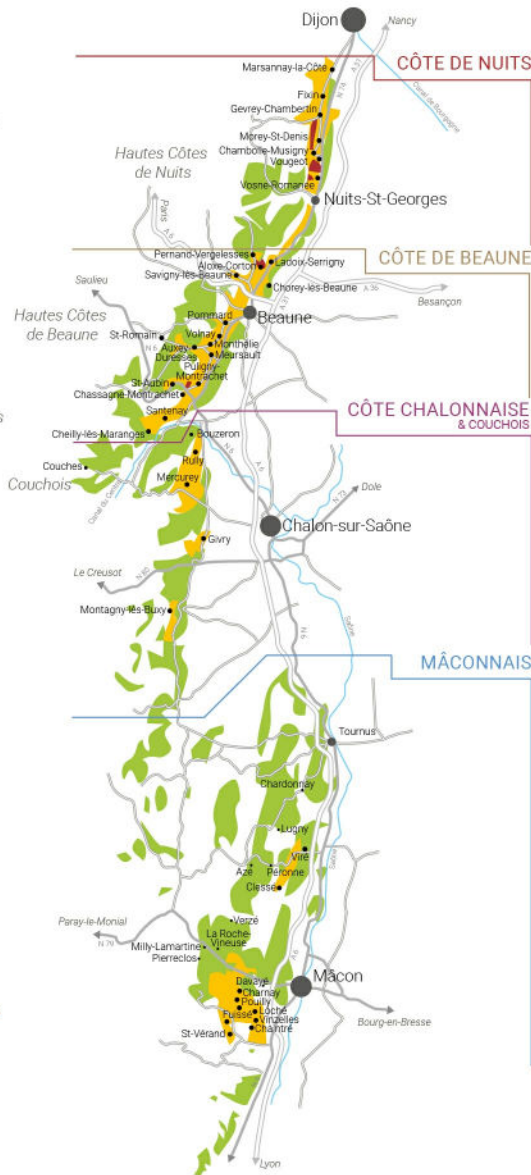

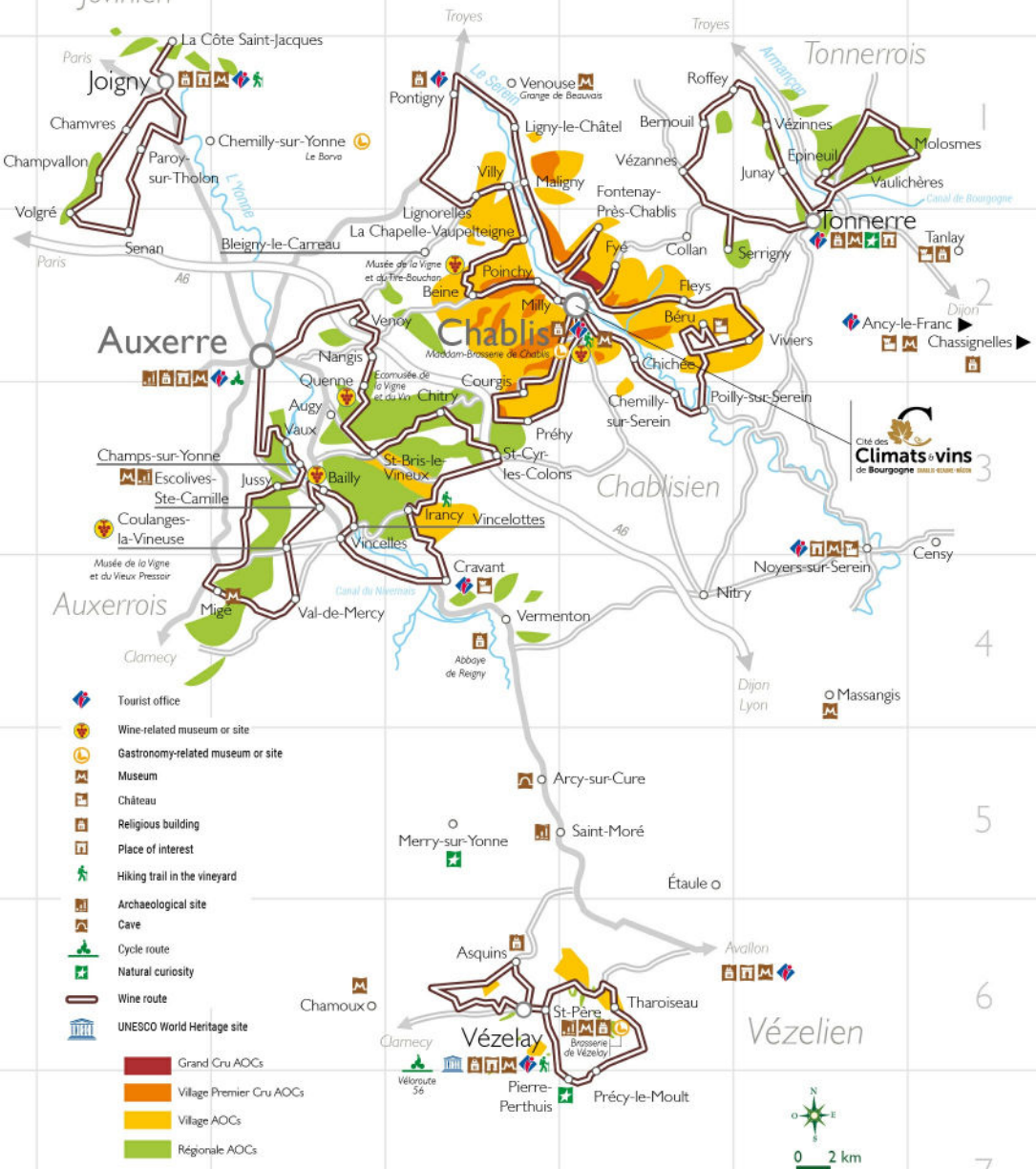

# Chablis & Grand Auxerrois

## The Yonne Vineyards route

The *Route Touristique des Vignobles de l'Yonne* winds its way through a diverse landscape, passing many different waterways and each valley has its own charm.

The Serein Valley, which passes through the Chablis area, reveals checkerboards of vines dotted on both banks. The river meanders lazily from village to village, in which you will cross venerable stone bridges.

Here, in this landscape of rolling hills and peaceful villages, there are many cellars waiting to welcome you. There, you will meet wine professionals whose greatest pleasure is to

share with you their passion for the terroir. You will discover that the wines of the Auxerrois and the Tonnerrois are very diverse, and that Chablis wines can teach your palate to capture an infinite number of mineral nuances.

The Vézélien is slightly apart from the rest, on the sides of the eternal hill of Vézelay, but the detour is a must.

The Yonne is also a wonderful place for hiking. You can discover the beauty of the winegrowing area and the charm of its villages as you follow a wide network of picturesque footpaths. If you are looking for something

a little more lively, then take a stroll through the narrow streets of Joigny, one of the most charming towns in the Bourgogne winegrowing region. And don't leave without paying a visit to Auxerre, the sophisticated capital of the Yonne, with its quaysides, cathedral and historic center.

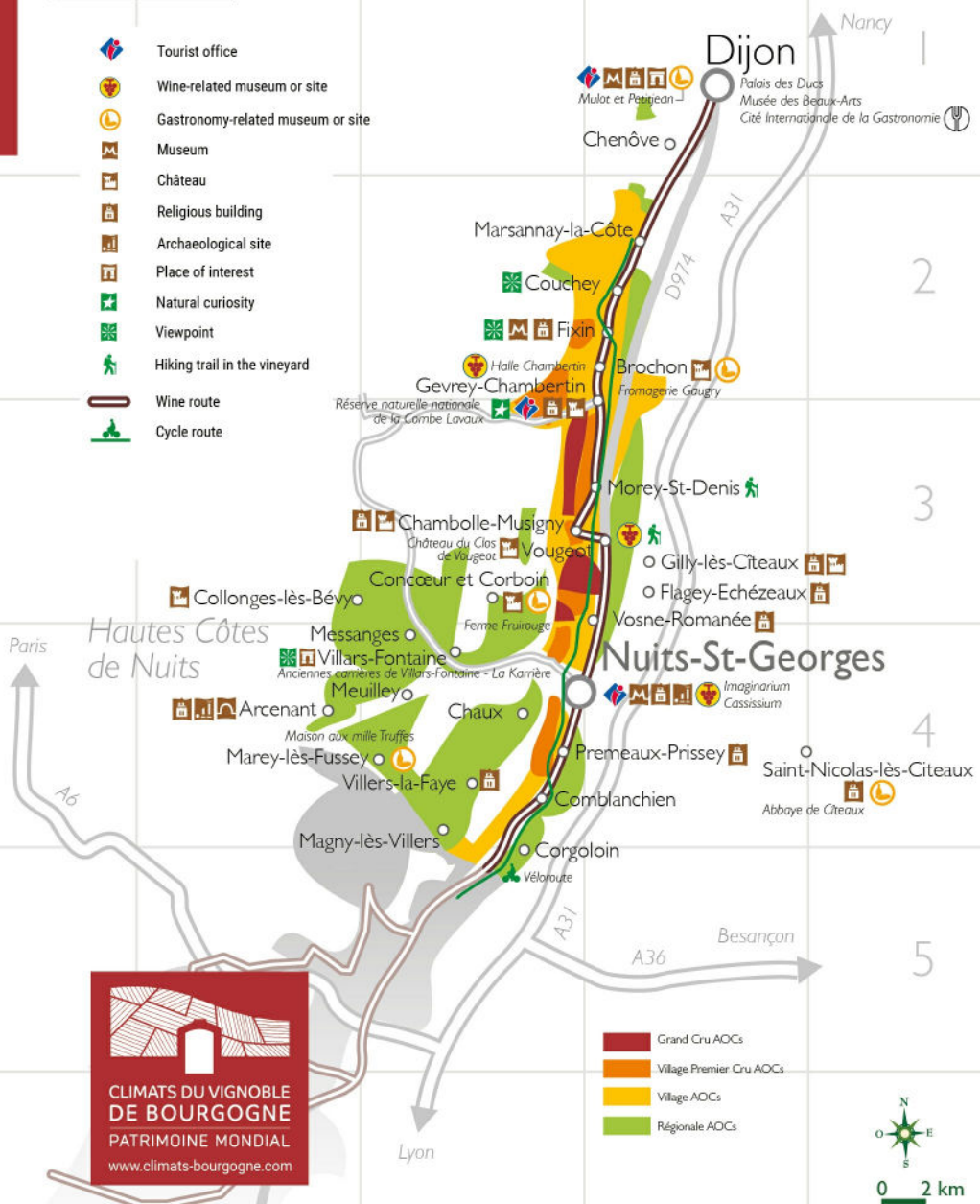

# Côte de Nuits & Hautes Côtes de Nuits

## The Grands Crus route

The *Route des Grands Crus de Bourgogne* follows a signposted itinerary of some 60 km, running along the Côte de Nuits (opposite) and the Côte de Beaune.

The Route, which will celebrate its 90th anniversary in 2027, is the oldest of France's wine routes. This route will take you through the heart of wine-producing villages with prestigious names, including Chambolle-Musigny, Vougeot, Vosne-Romanée (home of the famed Romanée Conti) and Nuits-Saint-Georges.

As soon as one leaves Dijon to the south, the hillside appears. The slope is at first quite sharp, and then becomes less steep, revealing the patchwork of *Climats*.

Certain villages nestle in the shelter of valleys, which create

the physical link between the Côte and the Hautes Côtes.

History has bestowed a rich legacy upon the Côte de Nuits. The *Abbey of Cîteaux*, cradle of the Cistercian order, and the Renaissance château of *Le Clos de Vougeot* (head-quarters of the *Confrérie des Chevaliers du Tastevin*) are essential places to visit. Overlooking the hills of Gevrey-Chambertin as far as the *Corton* wood, the Hautes Côtes de Nuits has a more wild kind of beauty, which invites you to discover the villages with their sleepy little streets.

Dijon, the "city of 100 bell towers", will delight you with the elegance and charm of its historical center, its half-timbered houses, its cobbled streets, noble houses. Don't miss the International Cité of Gastronomy and Wine which

opened in 2022, or the Museum of Fine Arts, which has had a total makeover in its home within the splendid palace of the dukes of Bourgogne, who, for many centuries, acted as ardent ambassadors for the region's wines.

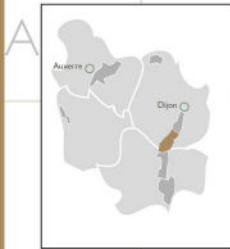

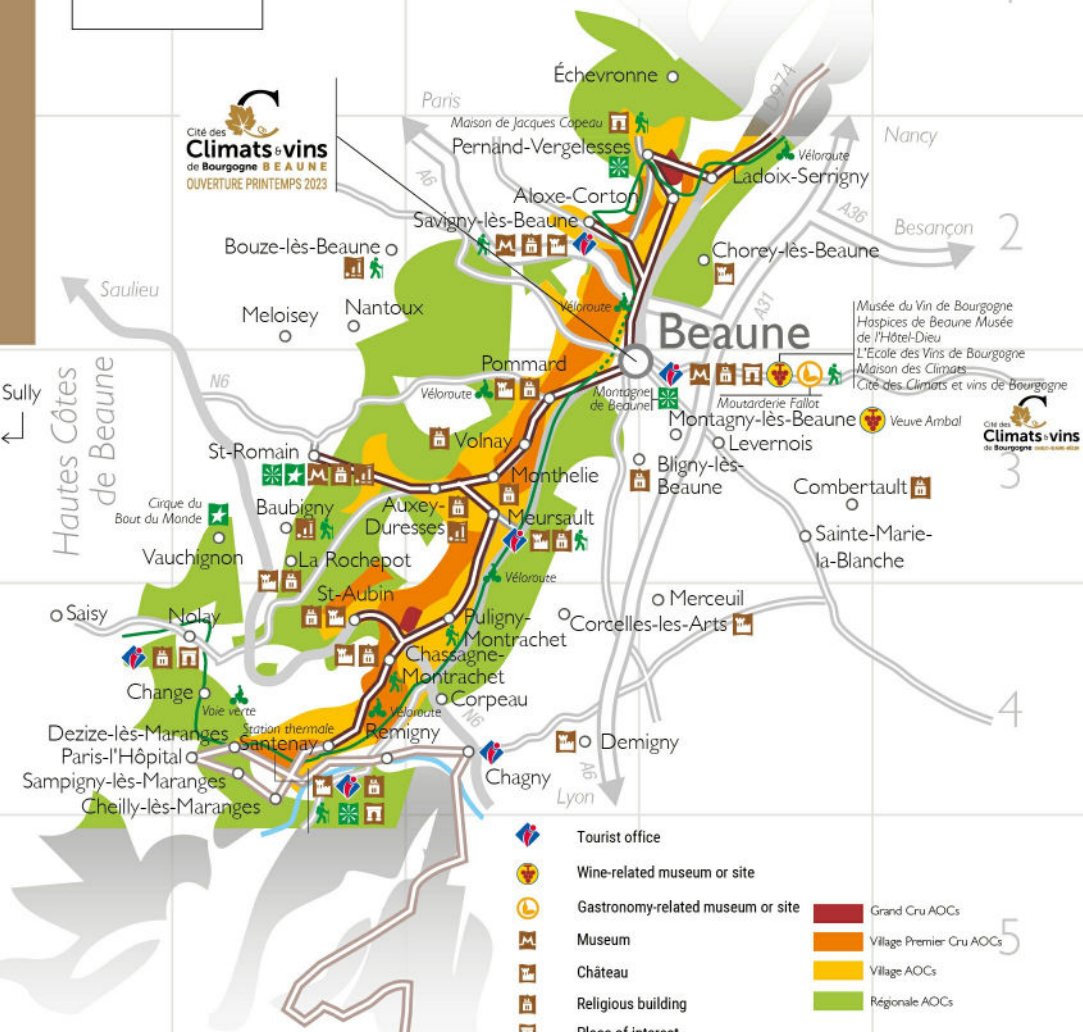

## The route des grands crus de Bourgogne

In the southern part of the *Route des Grands Crus de Bourgogne*, you will find a natural environment that lends itself to exploring. Take your time. The region has a wealth of wonderfully-preserved villages. Elegant winemakers' residences are also home to cellars, where you can taste the wines and meet the folk who make them. To the north of Beaune, on the land around the villages of Aloxe-Corton, Pernand-Vergelesses and Ladoix-Serrigny, some of the world's greatest wines are produced. To the south, you will find the château of Pommard, Meursault, Chassagne-Montrachet and more besides. The villages are often opulent, with splendid private residences of wine merchants who prospered in the area in the 18th and 19th centuries. Clustered around the church, fountains or wash-houses, these villages are

emblematic of the Bourgogne wine region.

### The Hautes Côtes

Stretching from the top of the hills to the west, from Ladoix-Serrigny to the hill-sides of Maranges, the series of valleys and hills are carpeted with vines on the sunnier slopes. With its villages of white stone houses, the route here has a radiant and quiet charm.

### Then Beaune, of course...

All visitors fall under Beaune's charm. Within the town's ramparts, the capital of Bourgogne wine has preserved an incomparable historical heritage: the Church of *Notre-Dame*, the Wine Museum housed in the former ducal palace, the noble residences, the half-timbered houses. But the jewel in the crown is undoubtedly the *Hôtel-Dieu*, with its gothic façades and colored

tile roof, this former hospital owned by the *Hospices de Beaune* is a testimony unique to the civic architecture of the Middle Ages. Since the spring of 2023, the Cité des Climats and Bourgogne wines embodies the entirety of Bourgogne's history, its know-how and its wine-growing heritage

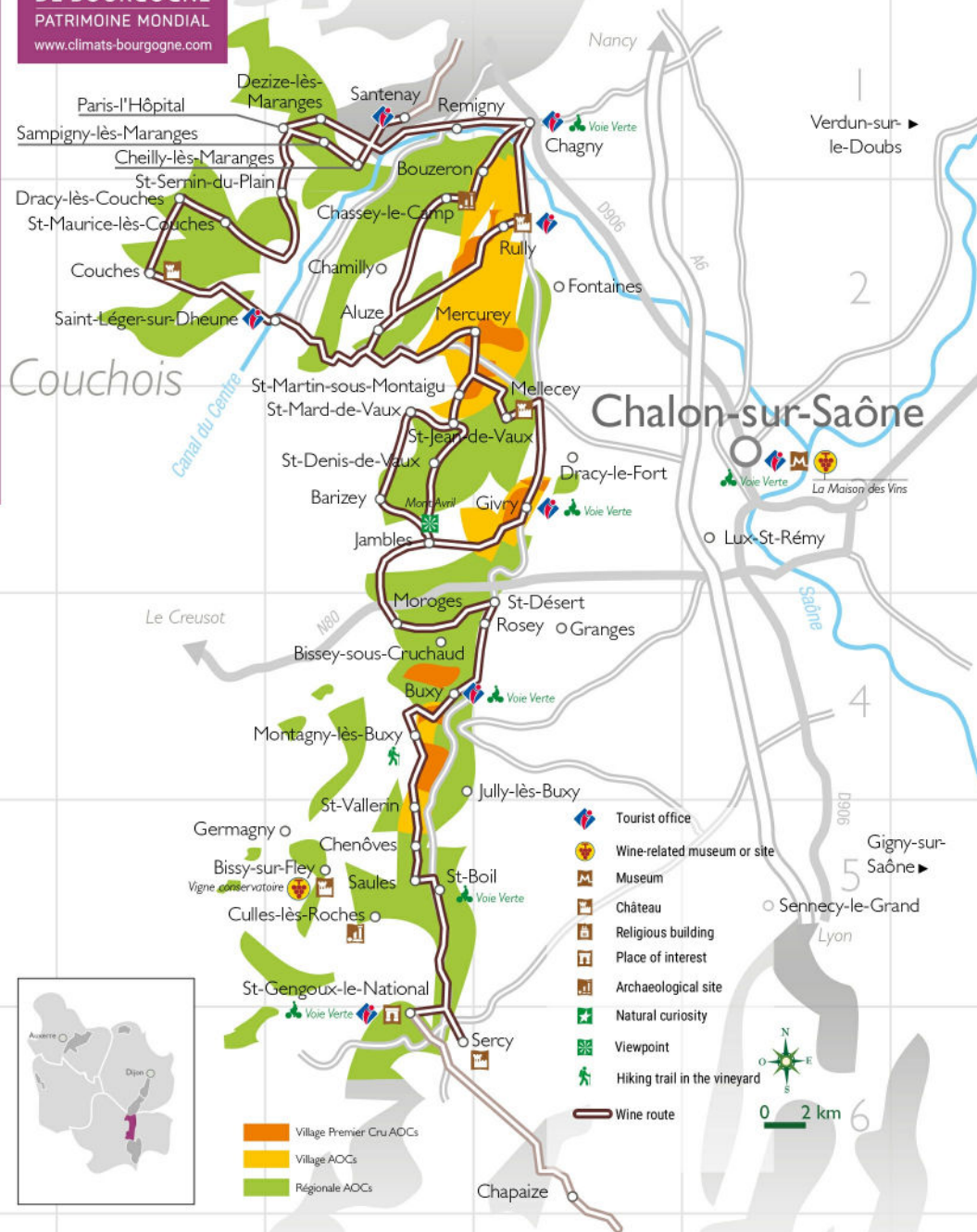

Along the length of this wine-related trail through the Côte Chalonnaise, you can use Route71 app to guide you from village to village, and from cellar to estate. From Chagny, a renowned gastronomic stopover, to the medieval town of Saint-Gengoux-le-National, the Côte Chalonnaise offers you a trip as varied as its wines.

In this southern part of Bourgogne, the vineyards and the bocage share the hills, forming a landscape of great gentleness, never monotonous. The Côte Chalonnaise is a paradise for strollers. The charms of nature can be enjoyed by foot, by bike, but also by barge. *The Voie Verte* (Green Way) which runs along the bucolic *Canal du Centre* and the Montagny wine trail will delight lovers of peaceful moments.

In each village, you will discover welcoming cellars and splendid wine estates where you will be introduced, glass in hand, to

the secrets of the wine and the seasons. The *Maison des Vins* in Chalon-sur-Saône will also invite you to taste the appellations of the Côte Chalonnaise.

The Côte Chalonnaise Great Wine Route is a fascinating history book. The past is told through Romanesque churches and a whole heritage preserved, such as the *Pontus de Tyard* castle in *Bissy-sur-Fley*, the Germolles castle or the majestic fortress of Rully.

Chalon-sur-Saône promises you other encounters with history. City of photography, its city centre has a unique charm with its small lively squares, half-timbered facades, the elegant residences of the wine cellars and the beautiful *Saint-Vincent* cathedral.

### Make a detour through the Côtés du Couchois...

Finally, a small island of vines nestled between the Côte Chalonnaise and the Monts du

Morvan, the Côtés du Couchois are a wine-growing area of Bourgogne with great character! Closing the geological fault that starts from Dijon, the vineyard is located in the extension of the Côte de Beaune. The vines climb up the favorable slopes of a hilly terrain, offering remarkable panoramic views. They flourish on a clay-marly soil (versicolour clays) very favorable to *Pinot Noir* and Chardonnay. The AOC Bourgogne Côtés du Couchois is a ruby-coloured wine, with fruity notes, robust tannins and a fresh finish. This AOC is now fighting to have its charming white wines also recognized. This little piece of Bourgogne will captivate happy curious and discerning gourmets.

will also no doubt take you to the Abbey of Cluny. This former Benedictine site was the center of Christianity during the whole of the Middle Ages. Marked by this influence, the southern part of the Bourgogne winegrowing region offers a concentration of Romanesque churches, among the most important in France. The area's chateaus and villages also bear witness to this fabulous medieval legacy. The area's natural heritage is equally rich. Between the pink and ochre-colored hills

of the Cluny area, the bucolic banks of the River Saône, the rocky outcrops of Solutré and Vergisson, the vines grow in a constantly changing environment.

The Bourgogne vineyard is made up of a mosaic of small plots, some of which have recognized and historically identified qualities: the *Climats*

A *Climat* designates a parcel of vines, precisely delimited and named, often for centuries, which produces a unique wine. It benefits from special natural conditions (relief, geological nature of the soil, exposure to the sun, etc.), a history, know-how and is harvested and vinified separately, from a single grape variety. Each *Climat* has an evocative name that can be found on the bottle.



## Climates unique in the world, recognized as World Heritage by Unesco

Today present in various Bourgogne vineyards, the *Climats* first emerged on the current Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune. They represent a world exception: that of linking wine in a very precise and intimate way to its land of origin through the creation of more than 1200 *Climats*. Having become the model of local viticulture in the eyes of the world, they have been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List since 2015 for the wine and cultural heritage they represent. The inscription thus concerns the vineyard and its villages but also the landscapes, the emblematic built heritage, the traditions and know-how as well as the cities of Beaune and Dijon.



Several places allow you to discover the *Climats*: the network of *Cités des Climats* and Wines of Bourgogne, the *Maison des Climats* (free exhibition - change of location in 2023), the International City of Gastronomy and Wine in Dijon and many itineraries along the *Route*



*des Grands Crus*. An Association works for its part in the protection, knowledge and enhancement of the registered site.

# A responsible sector open to dialog

The winegrowers of the Bourgogne region are aware of the issues around the use of vine treatments, and are keen to respond to the demands of society in this area.

That is why they have committed to the **Regional Charter "Terroirs and Territory: A commitment for the future"**, which has several objectives:

- Encouraging each winegrower to have greater awareness about implementing best practices in the use of disease control products
- Explaining the work of winegrowers and ensuring communities live together in harmony

The winegrowers of Bourgogne are open to dialog, and would be delighted to show you their work and their terroirs.

Throughout the year, you see winegrowers busy on their land. The landscapes you go through require a **great deal of care**. But what exactly needs doing? What is each intervention in the vines for?

You can find the answers to your questions in the booklet **"Understanding the World of the Winegrower"**. Simple and accessible, it unpacks certain preconceived ideas, notably explaining that the presence of a tractor may mean various tasks are underway, from trimming to plowing to spraying. Such mechanical work does, however, require keeping at a safe distance.

So for your safety and so that everyone gets along when you are out and about in the vine, we recommend that you remain vigilant near any machinery that you may encounter, and respectful towards those working in the vines. 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## Objectif Climat

As part of the carbon neutrality strategy of France by 2050, the Bourgogne Wine Board has made a commitment, with its partner Adelphe, to launch the "Objectif Climat" project.

The objective of the Bourgogne wine sector is ambitious. Achieve **carbon neutrality** by 2035 with:

- a 60% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions,
- a strategy for offsetting incompressible residual emissions.

The Interprofession has built a methodology to deploy this project on a vineyard scale.

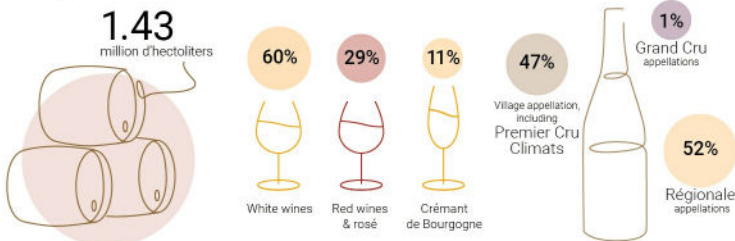

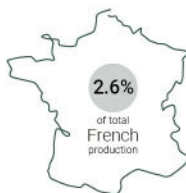

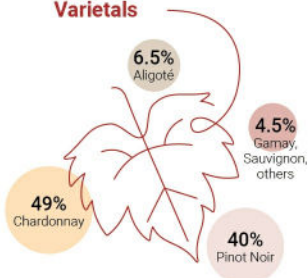

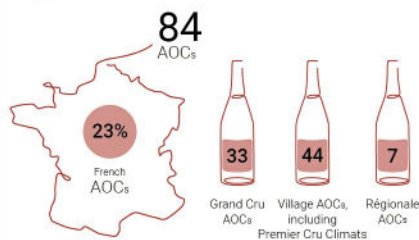

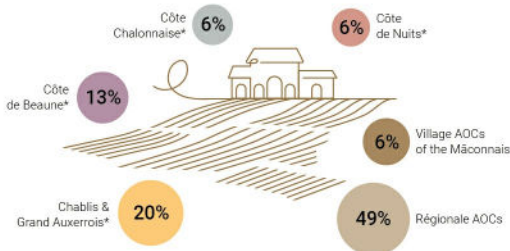

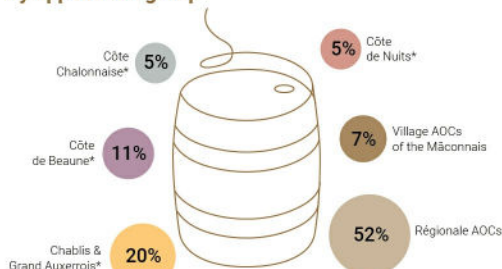


## Area under production by group of appellation
